Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord



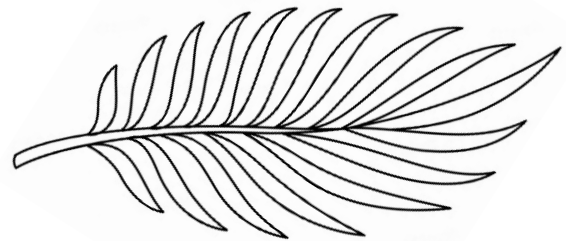
Gospel | Mt 26:14 - 27:66
Christ's Passion

The complete meaning of Palm Sunday is simple: it is the marking of the final days of Christ and his triumphant arrival into Jerusalem. We celebrate this feast down to continue telling the tale of Jesus Christ and celebrating his life, death, and resurrection. Palm Sunday allows church-goers to bring home their own palm fronds to bless their homes with the same victory the crowds of Jerusalem Christ were blessed with. As Palm Sunday is the first day of the Holy Week, its importance stands as the beginning of Christ's Passion.
