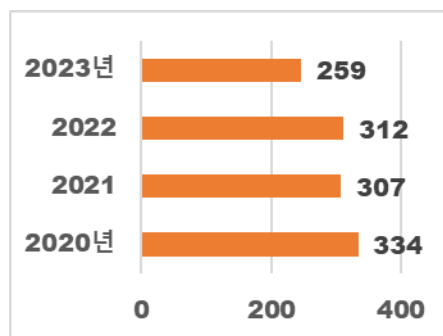

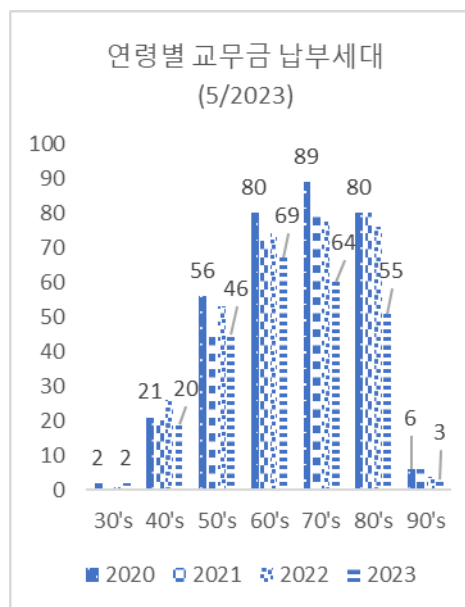
### ❖ Our New Director Update
