# The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

## In Today's Readings...

First Reading | Ex 24:3-8

***"This is the blood of the covenant that the Lord has made with you."***

Second Reading | Heb 9:11-15

***"The blood of Christ will cleanse our consciences."***

Gospel | Mk 14:12-16, 22-26

***"This is my body. This is my blood."***

*The readings for the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ - Corpus Christi Year B give background for the notion of sacrifice and explain why we call Jesus the Lamb of God. The first reading describes how the Israelites sacrificed animals to seal their covenant with God. The second reading explains Christ is our high priest, but he also demonstrates sacrificial love. And in the gospel Jesus institutes the sacrament of the Eucharist during the Passover meal.*

*Corpus Christi celebrates the Eucharist. It is a time to reflect on the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood. This feast day helps us appreciate Jesus' lasting gift in the Eucharist. Let us remember and celebrate this gift together.*

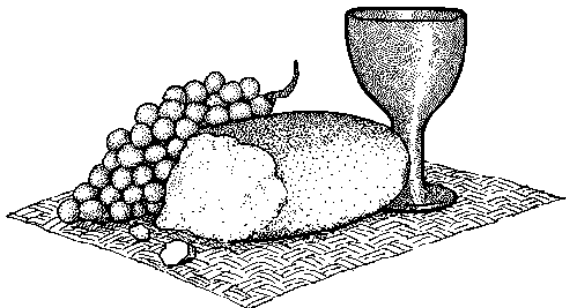
